The East Carolina Wildfowl Guild is a non-profit organization which was started in 1993 and is headquartered in Washington, North Carolina. The guild's membership consists of individuals who have an interest in various types of wildlife art, included but not limited to carving, flat art, sport artifacts, photography, sculpture, and many other mediums.

The primary event, sponsored by the guild, is the East Carolina Wildlife Arts Festival and North Carolina Decoy Carving Championships which is held in Washington, NC, each February. The show consists of many facets, some of which are a juried set of exhibitors featuring various types of art medium for sale to the public, IWCA sanctioned carving competitions with various divisions including the proclaimed NC Decoy Carving Championship, a wildlife art and decoy auction, a national competition for the North Carolina State Duck Stamp, along with the unveiling of the stamp at the Preview Reception for sponsors and invited guests. One can also enjoy the DockDogs Competitions as seen on ESPN and the Outdoor Channel, various children's activities, retriever demonstrations, the Southern Classic Duck, Goose and Swan Calling Championships and the Outdoor Wildlife Market, and much more to offer for the entire family.
